<b>Objective(s)</b>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Identify and mitigate threats to the safety of responders for the duration of the event.</li> <li>2 Utilize pre-deployed responder assets to provide a safe, rapid response and secure environment for all air show attendees throughout the duration of the event.</li> <li>3 Support and manage the significant traffic on Pensacola Beach with safe and efficient entry and exit strategies and traffic control plans for the duration of the event.</li> <li>4 Monitor all potential hazards and threats, responding with appropriate timely actions or mitigating strategies for the duration of the event.</li> </ol>			
<b>Operational Period Command Emphasis</b>			
The Pensacola Beach Blue Angels Air Show will be a three day event. Scheduled to be prep/setup starting Wednesday, limited rehearsals occurring on Thursday, full dress rehearsals on Friday, with the primary air show launching Saturday. Sunday will be a rain date for the Saturday Show.			
<b>General Situational Awareness (Weather, General Safety Message)</b>			
<p>1. Typical Pensacola Beach summer weather is to be expected with high humidity, heat, and the threat of sunburn on unprotected skin probable. Use sunscreen and shade to protect yourself and force hydration. Make it a personal mission to protect yourself from heat stress or exhaustion.</p> <p>-Expect high temperatures in the lower 90s, with feels like temperatures in the triple digits (not quite at the heat advisory threshold). Winds will be out of the northwest at 5-10 mph, becoming southwest in the afternoon. There is a 80% chance for scattered storms. A total washout is not expected. If there is thunder and/or lightning, everyone should seek shelter. An isolated strong storm is possible, but chances are low. The main threat would be frequent lightning and locally heavy rain, but gusty winds cannot be ruled out.</p> <p>-Remember heat safety tips: Stay hydrated with water, take frequent breaks in the shade (or A/C, if possible), wear sunscreen, know the signs of heat related illnesses, etc.</p> <p>2. Use extreme caution when operating vehicles or equipment. Large, distracted crowds of people are expected and they will not be paying attention to you or the vehicle you operate. Utilize proper vehicle operation procedures and utilize backbrakes when moving any equipment or vehicles in reverse. 3. Keep your head on a swivel and stay engaged! Your safety comes first. Situational awareness is the key to a safe and rewarding tour making this the safest and best air show ever.</p>

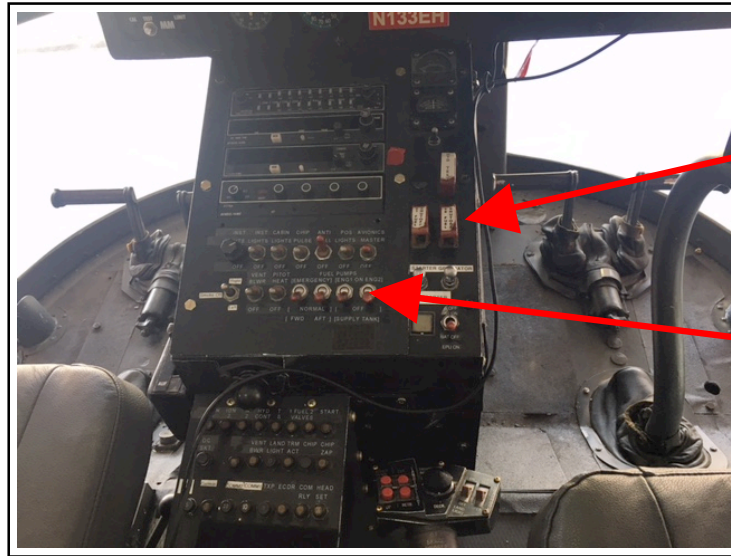

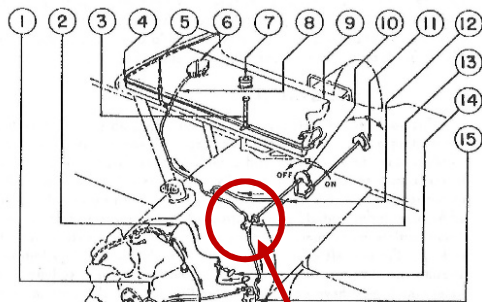

## General Aircraft Information

The aircraft is constructed of wooden wings and a steel tubular fuselage. The entire aircraft is covered with fabric, with the exception of the fuselage areas from the cockpit forward, which are covered with aluminum panels. There are four fuel tanks located forward of the pilot inside the fuselage. The forward two tanks typically have smoke oil in them, and the aft two have 100LL Aviation Fuel. The battery is located behind the pilot seat and in an emergency can be accessed by cutting the fabric on the side of the fuselage, just aft of the cockpit. If the aircraft is inverted, it can typically be rotated to an upright position by having two or more people lift on the tail. The canopy has two latches, one on each side. They are small metal tabs that need to be lifted simultaneously, while sliding aft. There are also two thin metal straps that may need to be cut with a knife. The canopy is very fragile and can be ripped off by grabbing the aft section and pulling forward, or by hitting it with a crash axe or hammer. The seatbelt is a typical "Hooker" harness with two lap belts. Each belt has a lever in the center that can be disconnected easily by lifting the lever up. One these two levers are raised, the entire belt system will release, allowing for removal of the pilot. The best way to extract the pilot is to pull on the parachute shoulder straps.

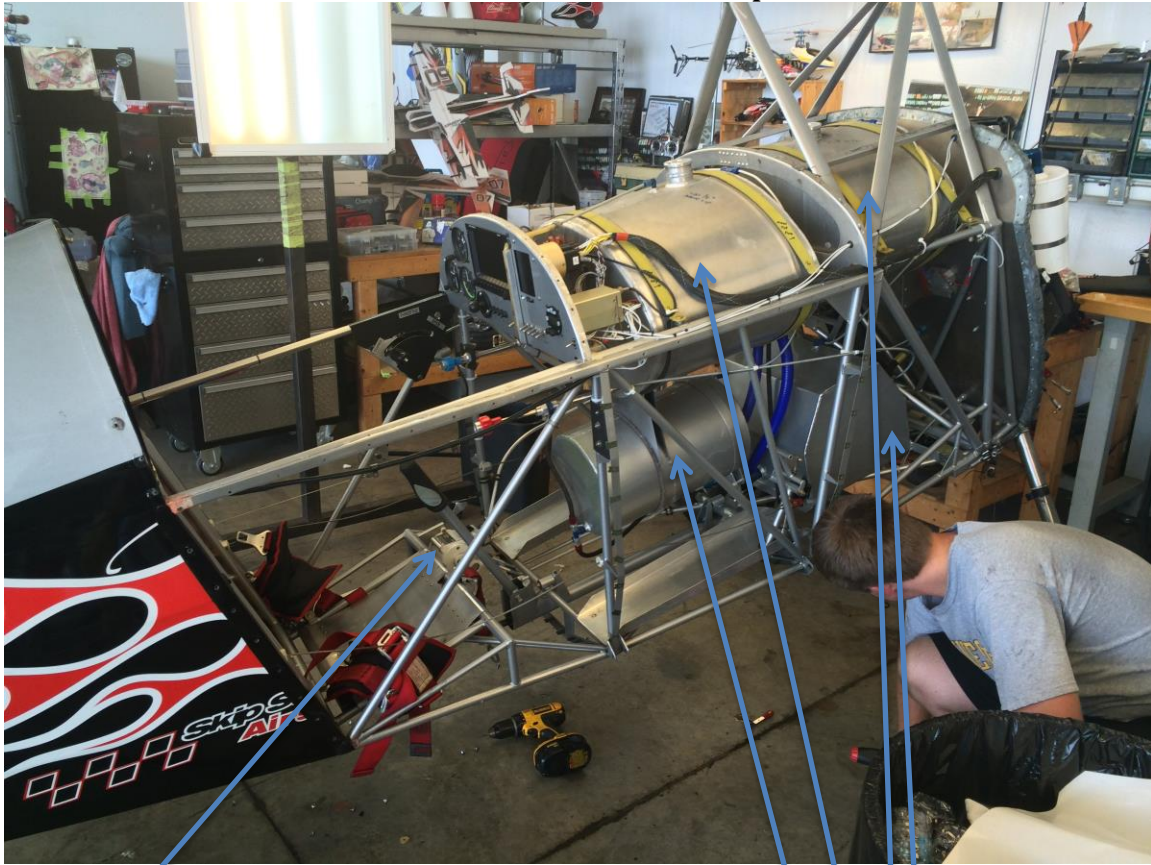

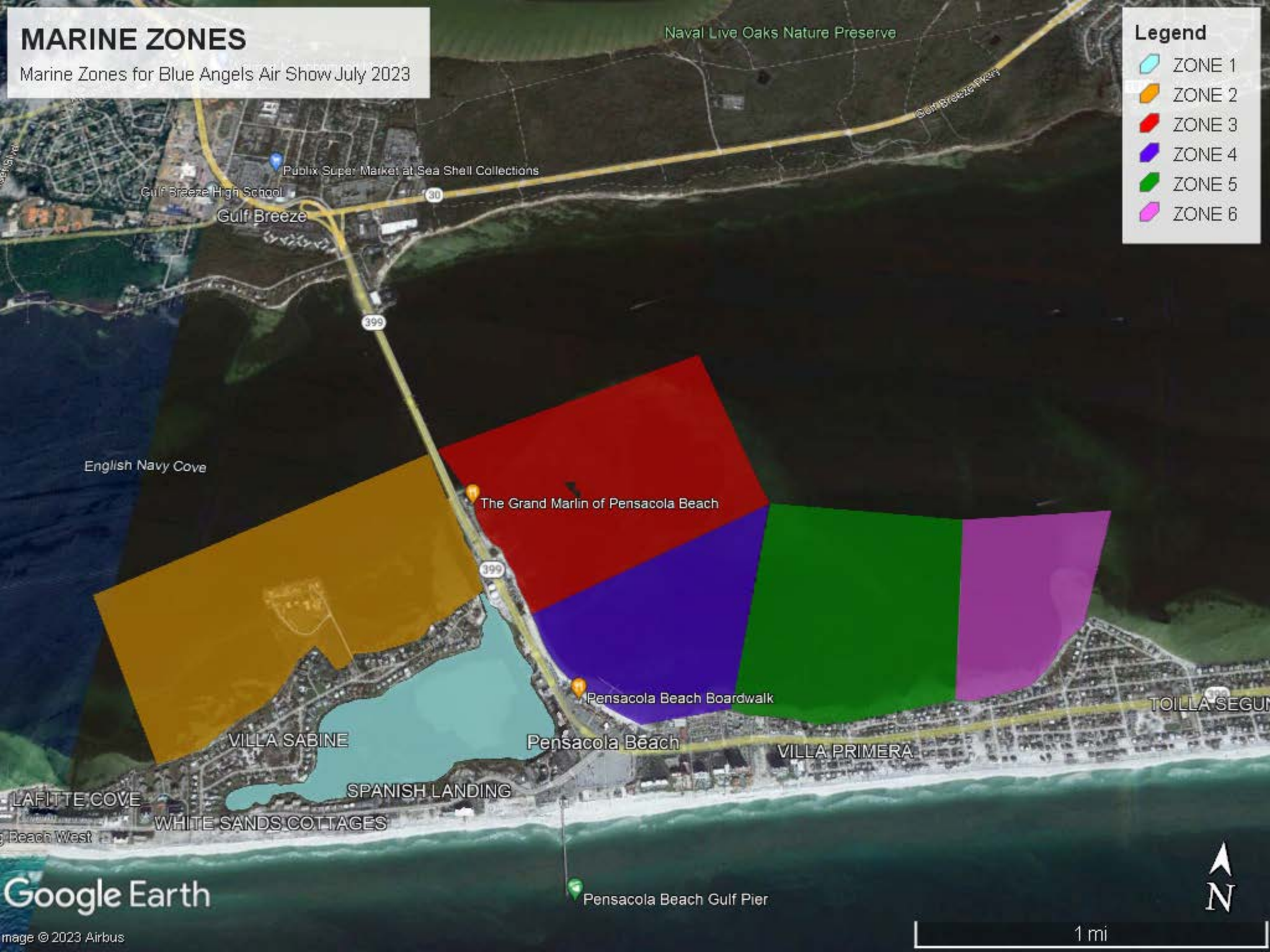
