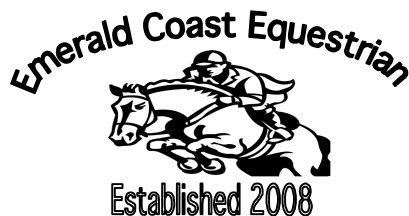

General Rules

- **These rules apply to only our show. If you go to a different show and compete in a higher division we will not penalize the contestant. We understand that shows offer different classes and different levels of competition.**
- Management shall settle any dispute or questions that may arise and its decision shall be final. Management can disqualify any rider due to inappropriate management of their horse. Inappropriate management pertains to all acts of cruelty.
- Protests must be made in the office within two classes of the results. Protest must be in writing. Protest cannot be made on flat classes unless the rider/horse in question has illegal equipment and the equipment must be pointed out to the ring steward prior to the class being dismissed from the ring.
- It is the riders responsibility to be at the ring on time and well prepared Since there is one ring there should not be any conflicts.
- Management may designate a jumping order and use a one minute gate call if necessary. You must cancel classes in the office or you will be charged.
- Age is as of January 1, 2010.
- Youth riders are 18 and under as of January 1, 2010.
- If a class has less then 3 entries then management can combined with another class or canceled. Any classes canceled by management will be refunded.
- All horses on the show grounds are to have a negative coggins and pay a grounds fee. If the horse schools the jumps, then a school fee is also required.
- Motorized Vehicles are to be operated by licensed drivers. All vehicles must be kept in designated parking areas. Trailers may be pulled to stalls to load and unload only, then moved to designated parking areas.
- **End of the Year Awards.** Persons wanting to participate in year end awards will pay a \$20.00 individual or \$50.00 family office fee to track their points.
- **Golf carts and ATV type vehicles** Management holds the right to ask operators to move or refrain from using this type of vehicle if they are being reckless.
- **Protective Headgear** – All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting, ASTM approved protective headgear on the show grounds when jumping.
- **Minor Exhibitors** – parent (s) or guardian (s) of a youth shall hold the horseshow management and the facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless entry is signed by a parent or guardian.
- **All dogs** must be on a leash.
- **Legal equipment and rules will follow the AQHA handbook. You can view a handbook in the office.**
- Riders/Horses limited to the division they show in for two years jumping, three years if the rider changes horse, or until the horse/rider exceeds 30 jumping points.
- **Awards:** Division Champion for Hunter, Jumper and Equitation. Classes 1 – 6th. Ribbons Saturday. Cups Sunday. Year end for Hunter, Jumper and Equitation.
- **Points:** For first place, maximum is 7 points and minimum is 2 points. Points decrease by one point to six place depending on how many persons are in the class.
- ***Forgiveness clause:*** *This will only apply for the first show of the year. If you enter a division and have great difficult and would like to switch to a lower division you may ask management for forgiveness. Please submit a letter in writing for documentation. We will accept hand written copies at the horse show.*

Crossrails, Small Fry and Beginner Youth will have a minimum of 6 jumps. All other hunter divisions will have a minimum of 8 jumps. All jumper divisions will have a minimum of 8 jumps. All equitation over fences will have a minimum of 6 jumps.

Hunter Under Saddle is rail work in both directs, walk, trot, canter unless otherwise specified.

Hunt Seat Equitation is a flat class with a pattern and rail work to the left, walk, trot, canter unless otherwise specified.

Hunter Hack is two jumps in any order except a bending line with rail work in both directions. Walk, trot, canter unless otherwise specified.

Equitation points will be maintained on the rider. The rider may change mount's if necessary.

Working Hunter, Hunter Hack, Hunter Under Saddle and Jumper points will be maintained on the horse. The owner of the horse must be a point tracker.

Please contact us for a complete show program regarding rules for each show and year end awards.

Leadline Riders 10 & under that need assistance. Riders will walk over 2 poles. Cannot cross enter into any other division.

Small Fry Walk/trot for riders 10 & under. Jumps will be 18" crossrail. Handlers allowed if needed. Rail work is walk/trot. Can only cross enter into crossrails walk/trot.

Crossrails W/T Beginner horse or rider. The jumps will be 18" crossrail. The jumps will be trotted. Rail work will be walk trot. Can cross enter into Small Fry only.

Crossrails W/T/C Open to any horse and rider. Jumps are 18" crossrail. Jumps can be trotted or cantered, simple lead changes allowed. Rail work will be walk, trot, canter.

Beginner Youth Youth riders who have not jumped over 18" at an ECE show. Jumps will be 18" cross rails and verticals. Crossrails are trotted and verticals are cantered. Simple lead changes are allowed. Riders may cross enter into crossrails WTC.

Intermediate Youth Youth riders who have not jumped over 2'3" at an ECE show. Jumps will be 2 feet. May cross into pony, horse, baby green and crossrails.

Horse Open to any horse and rider. The jumps will be 2ft.

Pony Open to any horse and rider. The jumps will be 2ft.

Novice Amateur/Youth Youth and Amateur riders who have not jumped over 2'9" at an ECE show. Jumps will be 2'6". Riders may cross enter into pony, horse, baby green, pre-green, amateur/youth, beginner jumper and crossrails. Novice AQHA riders can compete in this division regardless of the height they jump.

Amateur/Youth Youth & amateur riders who have not jumped over 3'6" feet at an ECE horse show. The jumps will be 2'9". Riders may cross enter into pony, baby green, pre-green, beginner jumper, intermediate jumper, Jumper, all age, and crossrails.

Baby Green Horses & Ponies who have not jumped higher then 2'6" at an ECE horse show. The jumps will be 2'3". Can enter any division that does not exceed 2'6".

Pre-Green Horses & Ponies who have not jumped higher then 3' at an ECE show. Can enter any division that does not exceed 3'.

All Age Horses & Ponies who have not jumped higher then 3'6" at an ECE show. Jumps will be 3'

Added Money Jumpers

If money is added there will be a \$20.00 entry fee for the second class of that division, 50% of the entry fee will be added to the pot. The horse/rider combination must enter the first class of that division. Payout will be through 4th place with a 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%. The added money course will be a power and speed course.

Beginner Jumper Horses & Ponies that have not jumped over 3' at an ECE horse show. The jumps will be 2'6". Cannot cross enter into other Jumper division.

Intermediate Jumper Horses & Ponies that have not jumped over 3'3" feet at an ECE show. The jumps will be 3'. To enter Intermediate Jumper II with payback the horse must enter Intermediate Jumper I. Cannot cross enter into other Jumper classes.

Jumper Horses & Ponies that have not jumped over 4' feet at an ECE show. The jumps will be 3'6". To enter Jumper II with payback the horse must enter Jumper I. Cannot cross enter into other Jumper classes.
