BACKGROUND:

Disaster Debris Removal and Recovery Services, PD 05-06.097 request for proposals was advertised on July 30, 2006 and received on August 18, 2006. Nineteen responses were received; two "no responses" and 17 submittals of proposals. Proposals were received for the provision of debris removal and recovery services that will be required in the event of a disaster as defined by FEMA and the State of Florida. Escambia County, at its discretion, will engage contractors party to this contract to perform disaster debris removal and recovery services that are in accordance with the Disaster Debris Management Plan and FEMA guidelines that are most advantageous to the County.

No funds are allocated at this time.
