

RISK MANAGEMENT TRAINING CLASSES

TITLE	LENGTH	DESCRIPTION
Bloodborne Pathogens & Disease Prevention	1.5 hours	Discusses health risks associated with CPR or First Aid. Recommended for employees with a high exposure rate to the general public.
Confined Space Orientation	1 hour	Discusses the dangers of working in confined spaces, as defined by OSHA.
Defensive Driving (Coaching the Experienced Driver)	4 hours	Certification required for employees who drive non-emergency county vehicles on no less than every other year basis.
Hazard Communication (HAZCOM)	4 hours	Provided for employees whose job requires HAZCOM certification.
Hazardous Chemicals Overview	2 hours	Discusses the hazardous chemicals a person might work with at work or at home and the best ways to avoid injury when exposed.
Heat Stress	1 hour	Explains the physical effects of working in high-temperature environments and how to prevent heat-related injuries.
Work Zone Traffic Safety	4 hours	Certification requirements for personnel involved in the planning, design, supervising, implementation, and maintenance of work zone safety. Certification required every two years.
Workers' Compensation and Post Accident Reporting Procedures	1 hour	Annual update / training on the County's workers' comp and accident reporting procedures.
Adult CPR/AED (American Red Cross Certification)	9 hours (2 days)	Initial certification for newly appointed departmental AED operators.
Lockout / Tagout Training	2 hours	Explains the procedures for locking out and tagging out energy producing equipment.
Forklift Safety	16 hours (2 days)	Certification required for employees who operate power industrial trucks.
Clerical Office Safety	1 hour	Discusses safety procedures for the office.
