Item B – The BCC has asked the CEC to develop a better strategy for determination of presence or nonpresence of the Perdido Key Beach Mouse on parcels located in Perdido Key. Tim Day gave the committee background information on the Beach Mouse. The committee requested additional time to determine this criteria.

Agenda Item VI, Landfill Operations Presentation

Ron Hixson gave the committee the adopted ordinance relating to landfills within the county and the current regulations of those landfills. Currently, the county has accepted some responsibility in permitting landfills from FDEP. These regulations are being fine tuned now so implementation can begin.
