Dr. Peter Shuba gave a brief update on the Escambia Treating Company groundwater report issued by EPA. This report was sent out to Ensafe and Pete Dohms of Gallet & Associates. These companies returned a review with the same information as what was included in the report. The report stated there were 3 things that needed to be defined with this study: 1) define the south border; 2) define the east border and whether the plume is going into or around Bayou Texar; 3) determine if there is a DNAPL layer. Once these questions are answered Escambia County is going to issue a resolution that will be forwarded to the CEC and EPA with their suggestions as to what cleanup measures need to be taken for the health and safety of the citizens.

Keith Wilkins, Director, NESD, suggested the CEC try to incorporate a smaller version of the State of the Environment Report. A copy of the Hillsborough County State of the Environment was given to all the members. This report could be done on an annual basis as well and would be easier to read. Mr. Wilkins also discussed the possibility of moving the CEC Meeting date to another day so the new member, Dr. Mel Droubay, could attend. There was some discussion on this matter however; no change was made to the calendar.

Sava Varazo gave a brief synopsis of what was happening at the Sauflley Field Landfill.
