After Dennis More Mothers May Qualify for WIC Program, Food Vouchers

PENSACOLA, FL – Often following natural disasters, mothers with homes that have been severely damaged need financial help from the WIC Program (Women, Infants, Children Program) to get formula for their infants and nutritious food for themselves and their children.

For this reason, the Escambia County Health Department today released information on how to qualify for the WIC program and where pregnant women and mothers of young children can register at county health department clinics.

Household Incomes That Qualify for WIC

For pregnant women, each unborn baby counts as 1 extra person in the household size

Household Size	Monthly Income before taxes and deductions
2	\$1,978
3	\$2,481
4	\$2,984

* for information on families up to 7 children, call WIC locally at 595-6670

Mothers Who Qualify for WIC Are:

- Pregnant
- Breastfeeding
- Mothers of Infants and children under age 5
