PENSACOLA, FL -- Beginning Wednesday morning and continuing through the week, the following services are available at the Escambia County Health Department 9:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Services that first re-opened on Tuesday July 12 are listed at the end. The health department expects to resume full services on Monday July 18.

**All Children's Immunizations Now Available at Main Health Department**

The Escambia County Health Department location at 1295 W Fairfield is now offering ALL immunizations for children 18 years old and younger. This includes the set of shots school children must have before returning to school on August 2nd. All other immunization services – such a shots for adults traveling overseas – are expected to resume Monday July 18.

**Infant Formula Now Available at Carver/Century School Mobile Clinic**

The mobile health department clinic stationed at the Carver/Century School distribution site will be dispensing powdered infant formula. Disaster victims should go to the mobile clinic for the formula; formula is not dispensed with water and ice.

**Vouchers to Buy Food Children Now Available at Main Health Department**

Mothers who don't have money to buy nutritious food for themselves or their young children can get grocery store vouchers at the main health department, located at 1295 W. Fairfield. The moms will be enrolled in the WIC (Women, Infants, Children) program for 30 days and can get infant formula at the health department as well as a check to buy food at the grocery store.

**Farmers Market Re-Opens Thursday to Cash WIC Checks**

The Farmers Market in Pensacola will open on Thursday and can cash the WIC Program (Women, Infants, Children Program) checks that enable moms to buy nutritious food for their infant children.
