### ***Escambia County- Hurricane Ivan Update Curfew in Effect***

- The Escambia County Administrator and Escambia County Sheriff announced that Escambia County, including the City of Pensacola and the Town of Century, is now under a curfew beginning at 7:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 15, 2004 until 8:00 a.m., Thursday, September 16, 2004. This curfew will remain in effect each evening as long as the disaster order is in effect. Officials would like to remind the citizens that this curfew is in effect for their protection and the protection of their property.
- The Sheriff's Office and City of Pensacola Police Department are responding to emergency calls only on a case-by-case basis.
- Escambia County Fire~Rescue announced that they are responding to life hazard calls only. These responses will also cease once weather conditions are no longer safe.
- Ambulance service is also being reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- All Emergency Calls need to be made through 9-1-1.
- Only general information calls should be made to the Citizens Information Line.
