Hurricane Ivan News Release

Citizens Information Line:

- The Escambia County Citizens Information Line will be changing its hours of operation beginning Sunday, September 26, 2004. The line will be manned from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. each day. The phone is (850) 595-3344.

Distribution Centers:

- The following **two** sites are open for the distribution of ice, water and food from **10 a.m. to 6 p.m. (please notice time changes):**
 - Northview High School – 4100 Highway 4 Century Fl
 - Old Warrington Village Shopping Center – 400 Blk N. Navy Blvd
- All other sites will be closed effective 6:00 p.m. Sunday, September 26, 2004.

Army Corps of Engineers:

 - Wal-Mart, 4600 Mobile Highway, Pensacola, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - Wal-Mart, 2650 Creighton Road, Pensacola, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
 - Food World, 6032 Highway 90, Milton from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
