Escambia County- Hurricane Katrina – Road Advisory

➤ **Road Advisory**

- Weather conditions continue to worsen.
- Residents are urged to remain off the roadways.
- Numerous roads have experienced flooding and are closed at this time:
 - Main Street
 - Main Street at Alcaniz
 - 9th Avenue South of Chase Street
 - Aragon Street
 - 17th Avenue at Bayfront
 - Gulf Beach Highway at Meadow Field
 - Portions of Fairfield Drive (**reopened**)
 - Michigan Avenue at Timberlake Mobile Home Park
 - All roads that normally flood in the downtown area
 - Eastbound Highway 90 from Pensacola to Milton (**reopened**)

➤ **Bridges**

- The I-10 Escambia Bay bridge closed at 2:15 am and will remain closed until further notice. Traffic will detour off at either exit 13 (Davis Hwy) or 22 (Avalon Blvd) to Hwy 90
- The Three-Mile Bridge (Pensacola to Gulf Breeze) closed at 1:15 am today and will remain closed until further notice.
- Garcon Point Bridge (Gulf Breeze to Avalon Boulevard) **reopened** at 5:00 p.m.
